Superstorm Sandy Continues to Focus Region's Attention on Infrastructure

U.S. Senator Charles Schumer says Long Island is among areas of New York slated to receive \$600 million in the final installment of federal recovery funds earmarked for infrastructure repair and strengthening as part of the legacy of Superstorm Sandy.

As much as \$525 million of those funds could be allocated for the bi-county region, according to Schumer.

Published reports say the key projects to be funded, subject to a state action plan, are for a nitrogen-removal system at the Bay Park Sewage Treatment Plant to protect coastal marshes in Nassau; river-widening and drainage-management portions of a plan for a "buffered bay" on Nassau's South Shore; and expansion and construction of sewer systems in Suffolk.
